Adjudication decisions awarded pursuant to the Construction Industry Payment and Adjudication Act 2012 ("CIPAA") are often challenged in court, by way of setting aside applications under section 15 of CIPAA and/or stay applications under section 16 of CIPAA. Practitioners tend to rely on a fixed body of authorities in arguing these applications. However, in recent times, there has been new case law on sections 15 and 16 of CIPAA which could provide practitioners with a fresh view on how to deal with these applications. In this webinar, the speakers will delve into these new case laws and discuss their effect on applications under sections 15 and 16 of CIPAA.
